

The purpose of this document is to guide to estate planners to determine what online data may be necessary for the administration of an estate. A decedent's digital footprint may be much larger than necessary to accomplish the goal of an executor, and likely contains extraneous and deeply private information that the decedent would not want disclosed. This form will assist in establishing which categories of data, and which specifically identified accounts, the decedent wants to be disclosed.

** This form is not meant as a stand-alone mechanism by which to require a service provider to disclose the requested data, as a provider may have no means to confirm that the author of this form is, in fact, the account holder. **

1. Do you have a Google Account? Have you activated Inactive Account Manager which allows you to direct what happens to content in your Google Account after you pass away or become inactive?
 - o *Selections within these tools will override any contrary instruction in a will or other instrument.*

2. Do you have a Facebook Account? Have you chosen whether to have your account memorialized or deleted in the event of your death? Have you designated a Legacy Contact, a Facebook friend who, after you pass away, can take limited actions with respect to your Facebook account, including writing a pinned post on your profile, responding to new friend requests, and updating your profile and cover photos? Have you permitted the Legacy Contact to download an archive of information you have shared on your Facebook account, including photos and videos, wall posts, profile and contact information, friend list, and events, but excluding messages, pokes, ads, and security and settings information? Have you considered whether to expressly consent to the disclosure of these excluded categories of information to a designated beneficiary in your will? If so, please identify the types of information that you would like disclosed and to whom you would like it to be disclosed below.
 - o *Selections within these tools will override any contrary instruction in a will or other instrument.*

3. Do you have bank accounts for which you only receive online statements?

4. List the email addresses for which you would like the entirety of the contents of those accounts sent to a beneficiary.
