#### **Sessions**

**Regulatory Update/Conversations with Regulators** - This forum will provide an informal setting for participants to hear what is on regulators' minds and to share experience and insights as a community bank board member. Members of the FDIC regional management team will highlight emerging issues, answer participant questions, and discuss topics raised by participants.

Session I – We've Been Hacked - This case-based session will take you through a cyber-security attack. Participants will work through developing a response plan, identifying missteps that contributed to the vulnerability, and determining steps to lessen the likelihood of future attacks. Participants will consider any consumer protection implications of an attack. The forum will also include discussions of IT oversight and cyber risk.

Session II – Balance Sheet Funding – Strategic Considerations – This module will focus on funding risk trends in the areas of concentrations, on-balance sheet liquidity, brokered deposits, and Internet deposits. It will also include a case study to illustrate the risk/reward tradeoff of funding strategies.

Large Group Case Study – We're Growing the Bank – Community banking prospects are positive, and many bank management teams are discussing growth opportunities. This interactive case study will work through various ways banks are growing. This session will incorporate lessons learned from prior banking crises, discuss relevant strategic planning considerations, and identify risks to consider going forward.
